RULES & IMPORTANT INFORMATION

(Please Read Carefully)

To ensure that the show runs smoothly, please keep the following rules and conditions in mind when planning your exhibit.

- All exhibitors will be permitted to buy, sell and swap. <u>NO</u> commission will be charged on any sales.
- The show's theme is <u>Decoy & Wildlife Art</u>. The public expects us to make every effort to maintain this standard. If your display is deviating from Decoy & Wildlife Art, you may be asked to remove items that are not appropriate.
- Exhibitors are required to provide their own backdrops and all appropriate table coverings; no bare tables are permitted.
- Space is limited. Displays must allow for proper entering and exiting between spaces and not interfere with neighbors. If your display is too large, additional space must be purchased. An attempt will be made to re-locate you to accommodate your display; however, if space is unavailable, you will need to adjust your display accordingly
- New exhibitors will be assigned space beginning <u>February 1, 2022</u>. We cannot guarantee space for previous exhibitors if application is received after February 15, 2022.
- The Festival Committee reserves the right to relocate an exhibitor in order to accommodate floor plans. The new venue <u>will require</u> a new floor plan.
- Applications received after February 28, 2022 will <u>NOT</u> be included in the Festival issue of "The Canvasback" magazine. Please call us if there is a problem complying with this date.
- NO SMOKING or Chewing Tobacco is permitted inside buildings or on the grounds at anytime.
- Alcohol is permitted in designated areas only on the grounds of the gym & auditorium of the former Havre de Grace High School.
- Pets are not permitted in the buildings.
- <u>COVID</u> precautions will be in-line with the State, County, Local and CDC guidelines at the time of the Festival.
